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Background and skills

You will be expected to bring know-how and experience from previous positions, which enables you to contribute to the Group's efforts from day one. Therefore, you need a background from similar roles in a larger international company in the VGRR industry, or other automotive aftermarket industries. You could also have solid experience from industries with similar supply/distribution characteristics. As we are looking to establish a pan-European supply and distribution platform, you will need substantial experience from working in an international context. Multiple language skills are an advantage.

To have the right fit for this position, you need highly developed inter-personal skills, documented leadership skills and a background as part of an international Group Management Team.
